Below are the times that families are asked to come to the school for this process. Families are asked to adhere to these times as much as possible to ensure that we facilitate this process in a manner which is safe, efficient, and respectful of social distance guidelines.

**Please bring any textbooks, library books & school materials to the school during this time. Please note, there will be another opportunity in a few weeks to return SEA Equipment and Chromebooks that have been borrowed if you are still using these items for distant learning.**

The procedures will be as follows:

1. Please park your vehicle and go to the gym doors at the side of the building (walk towards the portables past the propane tanks).
2. Stand in line to wait to collect your child(ren)'s belongings. Items have been bagged by school staff and will be given to you when it is your turn in line.
3. Please deposit textbooks, library books and other school property (uniforms, etc.) on the designated tables.
3. Collect any additional items that your child may have left at school that were in the classroom or hallways (shoes, clothing). These items will be set out on tables organized by teacher name.
4. Please note that students/families will not be permitted entry to the school building or classrooms.
5. Please ensure you are respecting social distancing guidelines (2 metres) at all times while on the school property.

We ask that all families be efficient in their pick-up of materials and return to their vehicles immediately following the collection of material to make room for the next set of families arriving. Although it may be exciting to see other families and friends, we need to ensure we are following provincial protocols regarding both gatherings and social distancing. When possible, please limit the visitors to one per family. Thank you very much for your cooperation in helping to keep everyone safe.
